

## Suggestions For Workshop Critiques

1. Listen carefully as the rollo is presented. Make notes if necessary during the rollo to remember suggestions. At the completion of - the rollo, pause a few minutes. Reflect on what you have heard, review the outline for the rollo, and then write your comments, thoughts and ideas.
2. Ask yourself the following questions:
  - (a) Was the purpose of the rollo stated?
  - (b) Did he indicate what was going to be covered?
  - (c) Did he cover it according to the outline?
  - (d) Did he make effective use of the scripture?
  - (e) Did he give appropriate witness to the talk?
  - (f) Did he speak too slowly? Too fast?
  - (g) Was his eye contact good?
  - (h) Is the talk too long? Too short?
  - (i) Was there a summary?
3. Present only constructive comments. If you have nothing to offer, or if someone has already mentioned your point, feel free to pass.
4. **REMEMBER!** The candidates are waiting and relying on you to make this an unforgettable Cursillo for them. Christ needs your wisdom, insights and personal talents to witness to His presence.
